George Hovhannisyán passed away at 74 years of age in Yerevan, Armenia on January 26th of 2013.

He belonged to the generation of enthusiasts who were passionately trying to bring the tourism & hotel management in Armenia to worldwide standards. Being an excellent manager George would drive himself to improve and upgrade his hotel at every available opportunity. His involvement in “Hotel Management” course in NSU in Fort Lauderdale, FL in 1994 contributed to the improvement of many aspects of “Dvin” hotel in Yerevan, Armenia where he was a manager nearly a decade.

George was a devoted husband, caring father and a grandfather. He left behind his beloved wife Julia Jufalakyán, his two daughters – Lusine and Suzanna, and two grandchildren – David and Lilit.
