Safe Worship & Fellowship at St. Hagop

St. Hagop is open for in person worship, adhering strictly to Covid-19 prevention guidelines. For those who are medically vulnerable, elderly or sick in any way, we ask you to forego attendance until risk subsides further. For worshippers we ask your full cooperation in following these rules:

- *All participants must wear facemasks at all times, no exceptions. Masks provided for those without.
- *Participation in the altar and choir will be limited and by invitation only
- *Parishioners must sit 6 feet apart in the sanctuary, 10 ft in the choir & altar
- *Church will sanitized before worship and sanitizer provided throughout

Note to Online Worshippers: For Sundays of Lent, our livestream will begin later at **11:15AM**, and end at **12:15PM**. We will livestream the beautiful Sunrise (Arevagal) service and the '5 Signs of Healthy Church Culture' series.

Note to In-Person Worshippers: The time of in-person worship has not changed from **10:30AM-12:15PM**. The choir & priest will start the closed curtain Lenten Badarak earlier in order to offer the beautiful Sunrise Arevagal service thereafter.
