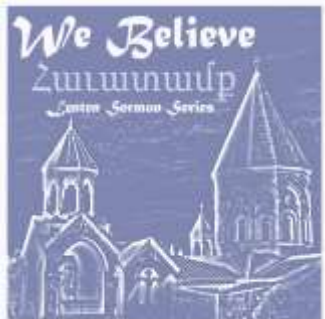
Sunday School Outing on March 15th!
