St. Hagop Re-Open For Worship

St. Hagop is open for in person worship. However, for those who are medically vulnerable, elderly or sick in any way, we ask you to forego attendance until risk subsides further. For all others, we will strictly adhere to mask and social distancing safety procedures, which restrict full worship and fellowship for some time. We ask your full cooperation and patience.

- *All participants must wear facemasks, no exceptions. Masks provided at door for those without.
- *Participation in the altar and choir will be limited and by invitation only
- *Parishioners must sit 6 feet apart in the sanctuary
- *Church will sanitized before worship and sanitizer provided throughout sanctuary
- *Children in attendance must stay with parents in church. There is no Sunday school.

Update on Our Aid to Artsakh & Armenia

The St. Hagop Parish Council unanimously voted to give **\$10,000** for Artsakh humanitarian aid from church savings and invited our community to try and match this donation with \$10,000 more in individual donations.

We are gratified to report that an additional **\$18,001** was collected as of 10/15/2020. To date, St. Hagop has transferred **\$28,001** to our Diocese, who is transferring 100% of our collected parish monies to All Armenian Fund Artsakh Aid.
