For all others, we will strictly adhere to mask and social distancing safety procedures, which restrict full worship and fellowship for some time. We ask your full cooperation and patience.

- *All participants must wear facemasks, no exceptions. Masks provided at door for those without.
- *Participation in the altar and choir will be limited and by invitation only
- *Parishioners must sit 6 feet apart in the sanctuary
- *Church will be sanitized before worship and sanitizer provided throughout sanctuary
- *Children in attendance must stay with parents in church. There is no Sunday school.

Update on Our Aid to Artsakh & Armenia

The St. Hagop Parish Council unanimously voted to give **\$10,000** for Artsakh humanitarian aid from church savings. We are gratified to report that this donation was matched and exceeded by our community with an additional **\$22,351** donated as of 11/12/2020. To date, St. Hagop has collected **\$32,351** and has sent 100% of funds to our Diocese, who is transferring 100% of funds to All Armenian Fund Artsakh Aid.
